ORDINANCE NO. 99-10

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MORRIS, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

SOLICITATION ORDINANCE

SECTION 1. The Town Council of the Town of Morris finds and declares all of the following:

There will be NO DOOR-TO-DOOR SOLICITATION of any kind after dusk or 7:00 p.m. (which ever comes first) each day in the town limits of Morris. This is for the safety of those being solicited as well as the solicitors. Any exceptions to this ordinance would need to be brought before and approved by the Mayor or Chief of Police.

SECTION 2.

All members of a company doing door-to-door solicitations will be required to wear a permit badge, which will be obtained from the Town Clerk after license fees are paid. The business license will be valid for one (1) week from date of purchase. Each organization will be limited to four (4) members. Registered non-profit or tax-exempt organizations will be excluded.

SECTION 3. The fines for the above mentioned offense(s) shall be as follows:

- First offense \$25.00 fine
- Second offense \$50.00 fine
- Third Offense \$250.00 fine
- Fourth Offense \$500.00 fine

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and publication as required by law.
